- doctoral students or holders of a doctorate,
- of all disciplines
- attached to a scientific research institute
- French-speaking candidates preferred

- **principle of organization of human communities aimed at the development of all**
Aristotle – Thomas Aquinas

- incarnated today through the **UN Sustainable Development Goals** :
(access to the conditions of a dignified life, education, culture, peace, preserved environment, etc...)

- research on the common good brings together all subjects of scientific research having a **societal and environmental impact** aiming for the development of all, helping to inform public debate and meeting transition challenges.
